Stud Dog Class* For Stud Dogs and a minimum of two, maximum of four, of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

Brood Bitch Class* Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Note As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

***Chapter 11, Section 8** of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

Brace Class This class shall be for two dogs (A Unit) of the same breed or variety of breed, irrespective of sex, belonging to an identical owner. Dogs may be entered for the Brace Competition Only or as an additional entry. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry. In making entries for Brace Class Only, full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If an additional entry, show Brace Class in "Additional Entry" portion of the entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace Unit must be designated "Brace #1", "Brace #2", etc.

Non-Competitive Special Attraction

Parade of Title Holders: To be held immediately following the lunch break and preceding the resumption of the regular judging. Varieties combined. Each dog will be presented with a Rosette with the Dog's name on it. All Chihuahuas that are AKC Titleholders of Record are eligible to participate in this non-competitive parade. The entry fee for this parade is \$16.00. Dogs do not have to be entered in another class. Show "Titleholders Parade" on the entry form.

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY: Non-competitive. Varieties separated.

Awards of Merit: Awards of Merit may be given at the Judges' discretion. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Variety, & Best of Winners Awards are made. All dogs remaining in competition are eligible for an Award of Merit. The number of awards are determined by the size of the entry of the Best of Breed Class:

2-10 entries -	1 Award of Merit
11-20 entries -	2 Awards of Merit
21-30 entries -	3 Awards of Merit
31-40 entries -	4 Awards of Merit
41 or more entries -	5 Awards of Merit

Novice Class- for boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class- for boys and girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

The winner of a third first-place in Novice Class shall automatically become eligible to enter in the Open Class at the show, provided the win is the third first-place award with competition and further provided there are one or more junior handlers competing in that Open Class.

Notice: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Event Records Department, (919) 816-3776.

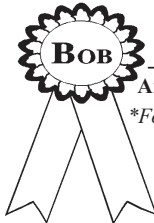

It will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to keep the area in and around their setup CLEAN and ORDERLY. PLEASE use plastic under all crates and exercise pens. DO NOT leave dogs running loose in the rooms. You will be responsible for all damages.

There will NOT be an exercise pen available for public use.

NO MORE THAN 10 DOGS will be permitted in each room.

A committee representing the club may inspect for any violations. All guests are responsible for the condition of their rooms and may be asked to leave the premises if the room is not kept in good condition.

Persons with dogs in their rooms should tip hotel maids generously on a daily basis (A \$5.00 a day minimum tip is suggested).

Video Equipment: All video cords must be taped down. Any accidents incurred are strictly the responsibility of the owner/operator of the Video Camera.

Exhibitors are not permitted to setup their dogs and equipment until show hours.

RV PARKING INFORMATION

Motor Home Parking is available, but will be limited. All vehicles must be self contained - NO HOOK UPS.

No discharge of waste/gray water on the grounds. No cedar shavings, or chips. Your parking area must be kept clean. The overnight parking is a privilege extended by the Hotel and the Dallas Chihuahua Club. We reserve the right to withdraw that privilege from any person(s) who abuse it.

There will be **NO** moving from assigned places without the approval of the parking chairman. **ALL PARKING IS AT YOUR OWN RISK!**

The show giving club assumes no responsibility or liability for damages to, or loss of dogs, any vehicle or its contents.

C.C.A. Guidelines For Hotel Maintenance

NOTE: Because some dog people have been irresponsible in safeguarding the property of hotels, it is increasingly difficult to acquire suitable housing for our shows, our members and our dogs. For this reason the C.C.A. is issuing the following guidelines for exhibitors to ensure that we are welcomed at hotels/motels.

1. If dogs are exercised in the rooms, this **must** be done in exercise pens. Do not blockade the bathroom, or closet, for example to accomplish this. To setup exercise pens, use heavy plastic as a base, with multiple layers of newspapers on top. Then place the exercise pen on top of the papers. The heavy duty plastic is pulled up above the "piddle" line about 8 to 10 inches and secured with clips or clothes pins. This protects curtains and furniture. Soiled papers must be removed and placed in plastic bags for ease of disposal. Do not expect the housekeepers to have to touch any soiled papers, and soiled papers must not be merely placed in the wastepaper baskets, as the scent of excreta and urine will penetrate the wastebaskets. **All rooms must be kept clean and smell clean.**
2. When dogs are left alone in the rooms, **they must be left in their individual crates.** Even "un-climbing" dogs have been known to climb out of their exercise pens when left in strange areas. And "digging" dogs have dug their way through their plastic and continued digging through the carpeting. This requirement of keeping the dogs in their crates thus protects the animals from escaping when the housekeepers come in, and of course, protects the furnishings.
3. **Dogs must not be allowed to run free in the room, whether the owner is present or not.** Many a dog becomes suddenly unhousebroken when it encounters strange odors in strange places.
4. Owners/exhibitors should bring their own toweling for bathing the dogs. **Hotel/motel equipment must not be used for cleaning up accidents,** owners/exhibitors must provide their own cleanup material ... paper towels, vinegar, "Fantastik" and the like.
5. Most hotels/motels that permit the use of their facilities for dog shows have a policy limiting the number of dogs allowed per room. **There will be a maximum of ten (10) dogs per room. This will be strictly enforced.**
6. **No dogs will be allowed on any carpeting,** including lobby rugs, halls, guest rooms, showroom, etc.
7. No exercising of dogs (outside) in any areas, **except those areas posted with signs as dog areas. Each person is responsible for cleaning up after their dog, inside and outside of the motel.**
8. No dogs allowed outside of their crates, unless in an x-pen w/plastic, or in the show show ring.
9. **No dogs allowed** in the lounge, lobby, banquet/meeting rooms and restaurants.
10. Some of the rooms have outside patios. You may set up x-pens on the patio, but **you must have plastic underneath your x-pens.**
11. Dogs must be carried in and out through designated exits/entrances only.
12. The only breed of dog that is allowed in the hotel will be chihuahuas. **No other animals will be allowed.**
13. Rooms must be made available for maids to clean daily. Do not disturb signs will not be honored during the day.

NOTE: A committee appointed by the CCA, and/or host club will be doing random room checks each day. Anyone violating the above guidelines will be asked to leave the hotel/motel immediately.

Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best of Breed judging on Sunday.

There will not be an exercise area available, but SMALL private exercise pens will be allowed. Due to space limitations, exhibitors may be asked to reduce or remove private pens at the discretion of the show committee.

The welfare of exhibitors children is assumed to be the responsibility of said exhibitor. It is directly understood that each exhibitor will exercise control and restraint over their children the day of the show.

No smoking is permitted at any time in the show room, banquet room, meeting or auction.

No Baby Strollers!

No saving of space with ropes, mats, chairs, etc.

Exhibitors need to provide mats or newspapers for exercise pens. They must be kept clean at all times.

Cell phones must be turned off in the showroom.

No video cameras, or cameras will be allowed at ringside.

No dogs will be allowed off the plastic in the showroom.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
