**From the North on I - 35 :** Exit Highway 380 (University Drive). Go east (left) about 2 1/8 miles to Carroll Boulevard. Go north (left) about 1/8 mile. Show Site is on the west (left) side.

**From the South on I-35W:** Exit Highway 380 (University Drive). Go east (right) about 2 1/8 miles to Carroll Boulevard. Go north (left) about 1/8 mile. Show Site is on the west (left) side.

**From the South on I-35 E:** Exit Highway 377 (Fort Worth Drive) and go north (right). After about 1/2 mile Fort Worth Drive bears left and becomes Carroll Boulevard. Continue north about 1 3/4 miles to University Drive (Hwy 380). Continue across University north about another 1/8 miles. Show Site is on the west (left) side.

**Show Hours:** The Show Site will be available to exhibitors Friday April 7, 2006 after 4:00pm to 7:00 pm Sunday, April 9, 2006. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging as stated herein. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. **No crates are permitted under the main tent by order of the local fire marshal. Any exhibitor who places a crate under the tent will be asked to remove it immediately.**

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**Prizes:** Trophies, Rosettes and prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog who shall be considered the owner or agent. All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging and the Show Secretary/Chairmen advised of any discrepancy. Trophies and prizes left at the show site will not be mailed to exhibitors.

**Exhibitors Are Reminded To Keep The Show And Hotel Grounds Clean.** Please put all refuse in containers on the show grounds and at the hotel. You are responsible for cleaning up after your own dogs. The club has provided buckets and pooper scoopers. Dogs are not permitted to run free on the show or hotel grounds.
