BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Awards Of Merit. This award is given at the Judge's discretion. The Award of Merit winners will be selected after the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex & Best of Winners awards are awarded. All dogs remaining in competition are eligible for an Award of Merit. The number of awards will be up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class. For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Award will be based on the merits of the Get. If the Get is not entered in one of the other classes in this show for which it is eligible, the regular entry fee must be paid. Entry fee is \$23 for Stud Dog Class only, or \$18 as an additional entry.

Brood Bitch Class. Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8 - a castrated male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class & a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or

bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

RALLY TRIAL CLASS

The Rally Novice A Class. Dogs competing in this class may not have won an AKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner's household or immediate family. The handler may not have previously handled any dog that has earned an AKC Rally title or any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility title. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After a dog earns the Rally Novice (RN) title, it may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

The Rally Novice B Class. Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A & B at any one trial.

The Rally Advanced A Class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) title or any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner's household or immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After a dog earns the Rally Advanced (RA) title, it may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A & B at any one trial.

The Rally Advanced B Class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A & B at any one trial.

The Rally Excellent A Class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner's household or immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After earning the Rally Excellent (RE) title, a dog may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at any one trial.

The Rally Excellent B Class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (RE) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at any one trial.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2).

An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms & Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission & identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Superintendent.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. **Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Postdated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Gasoline or Diesel Generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

No dogs will be allowed on the show grounds except those entered in the show. Dogs may arrive at any time prior to judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

The GPGRC, the Show Superintendent, the property owners, employees and any agent and/or members associated with the show will not assume responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained to exhibitors, handlers and their family, guests or to any dogs or property. Parents are responsible for the control and safety of their children.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Trophies, Certificates, Ribbons & Prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who shall be considered the owner or agent. All prizes and trophies must be picked up on the day of the show. No trophy, ribbon or prize will be mailed.

Trophies and prizes not claimed on the day of the event will become property of the Greater Pittsburgh Golden Retriever Club. **The reserves the right to substitute the listed trophies with ones of like or greater value.**

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
