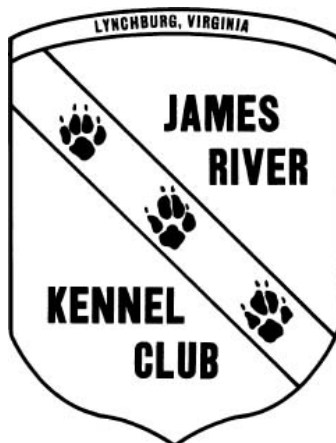

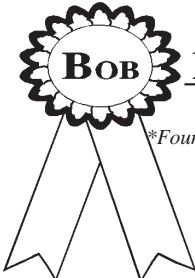

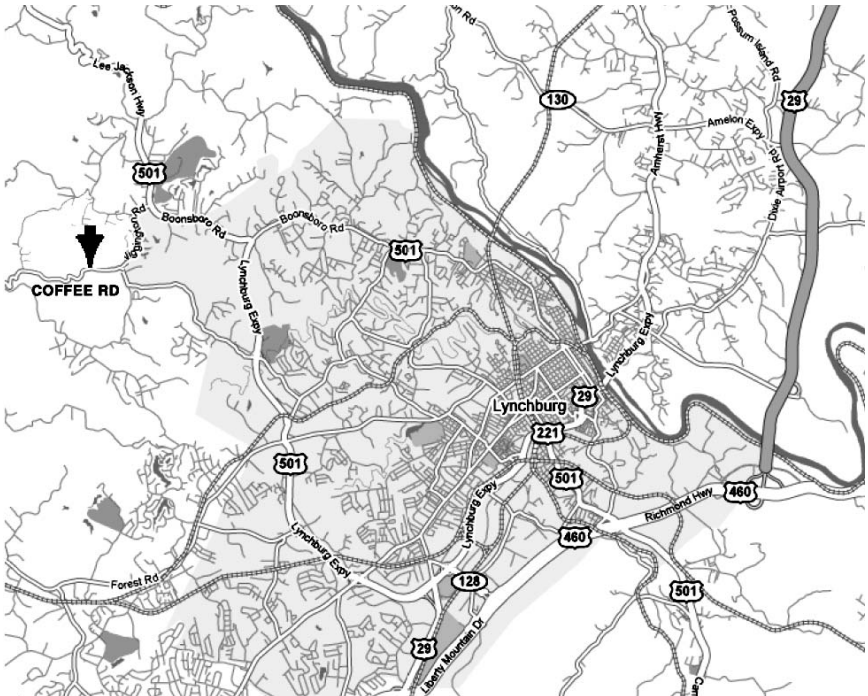
Follow the signs to Rt 501 N as you travel through Lynchburg. Here are the details.

US 460 - From the West of Lynchburg: From 460, take the right-hand exit to 460 E Business (Timberlake Rd). Proceed for about 3 miles. At the junction of Rt 501, exit to the right and follow 501 North for about 2 miles to a traffic light at Rt 221. *Continue straight on Rt 501 N through the light at Rt 221. At the next light, turn left onto Rt 501 North. At the next light, turn left (still 501 N) and go about 2 miles. Turn left onto Coffee Road (St Rt 644) and go about 2 miles. The Boonsboro Ruritan Building is on your right.*

US 460 - From the East of Lynchburg: Exit 460 at Candler's Mountain Rd (a right turn exit). Follow signs to Rt 501 North (River Ridge Mall will be on your left, and Days Inn will be on your right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt 29 South/501 North. Follow 501 N for about 3 miles. Follow the directions in italics above.

US 29 - From the North of Lynchburg: Follow Rt 29 South (do not use Rt 29 Business or Rt 501 Business). Take 29 Bypass around Madison Heights to 460 East, then follow directions from 460 East. (Bypass and 460 East meet)

US 29 - From the South of Lynchburg: Follow Rt 29 North into the city limits (pass River Ridge mall entrance on your right). Take the exit ramp to the right to Rt 501 North and proceed for about 3 miles to Rt 221. Follow the directions in italics above.

Dogs are not permitted to run free on the grounds.

Access to show site will be available at 4:00 p.m. Friday January 26 through Sunday January 28, 2007. Dogs must be removed overnight.

FAX entries for this show will be accepted up to closing time. For Mastercard/Visa cardholders ONLY. A \$5.00 charge will be added to each dog entered, plus \$1.00 for each additional class or item. Be sure to include cardholder's name, address, card number, expiration date & signature on back of entry form. **Front and back of entry form must be sent.** A \$2.00 Fee will be added for entry cancellations by credit card. Proof of transmission is not proof of receipt of a legible or complete transmission (AKC Rule Ch 11, Sec 4). **Phone number for Facsimile Machine is: 919-554-0519.**

Entry fees: \$24.00 for the first entry of each dog (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee & \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee or \$3 AKC recording fee if for Rally), in each Obedience/Rally trial, and \$24.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in the same trial.

Closing Date: 12 NOON (EASTERN), WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 10, 2007, at Show Superintendent's office, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted.

Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to Bob Peters Dog Shows, LTD., CANADIAN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Show Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2).

An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms & Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission & identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Superintendent.

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to judging. **Dogs not required** for further judging will be excused.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Postdated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Prizes: Trophies, certificates, Rosettes and prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog who shall be considered the owner or agent. All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging and the Show Superintendent advised at once of any discrepancy.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
