IMPORTANT NOTICE

Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility (revised 09/02)

Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which a dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle. Note: Under AKC rules, the breeder is the owner or the lessee of the dam on the date of mating that produced a litter.

No Entry Fees for Parade of Veterans or Parade of Rescue Dogs

STUD DOG CLASS: For Stud Dogs and two or more of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class, and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog need not be owner of Get. Entry fee is \$7.00 for Stud Dog and Get as a Unit. Get need not be entered in Regular Classes.

BROOD BITCH CLASS: For Brood Bitches and two or more of their Produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. Owner of the Brood Bitch need not be the owner of the Produce. Entry fee is \$7.00 for Brood Bitch and Produce as a Unit. Produce need not be entered in Regular Classes. A separate entry form must be completed and submitted for Brood Bitch and for each of Produce not entered in Regular Classes.

BRACE CLASS: For two dogs and/or bitches with at least one common owner. The entry fee for a Brace as a Unit is \$7.00. The dogs/bitches comprising the Brace must be named at the time of entry. If a Dog/Bitch which is part of a Brace is not entered in another Regular Class in the show, a separate entry form must be completed for each such dog/bitch, but no additional entry fee is required.

Best Puppy: Open to the dogs and bitches placing first in the regular puppy classes. **No additional entry fee is required.**

Best Bred-By-Exhibitor: Open to the dog and bitch placing first in the regular Bred-By-Exhibitor classes. **No additional entry fee is required.**

Parade of Veterans (Non-Competitive): Open to all dogs and bitches (Champions and Non-Champions) who, on the day of the show, are 8 years of age or older. A Sash with the Potomac Afghan Hound Club's logo and a certificate of participation will be awarded. No entry fee. **Entries in this class may not be entered in any other class at the specialty.**

Parade of Rescue Dogs (Non-Competitive): Open to all Afghan Hounds, dogs or bitches, rescued and adopted into loving homes. Please pass this premium list to those people that you know have adopted rescue Afghans, and, further, encourage them to fill out a rescue entry form and join us at the specialty. A rosette and certificate of participation will be presented to each entrant.

THE 2006 POTOMAC AFGHAN HOUND CLUB SPECIALTY WILL BE HELD AT THE LANCASTER HOST RESORT & CONFERENCE CENTER IN LANCASTER, PA. THE BALTIMORE/ WASHINGTON INTERNATIONAL (BWI) AIRPORT & PHILADELPHIA INTERNATIONAL (PHL) AIRPORT ARE BOTH APPROXIMATELY A 90 MINUTE DRIVE. HARRISBURG AIRPORT IS 30 MINUTES.

ROUTES TO SHOW SITE

From Baltimore: Take I-83 North to Rt. 30 East. Stay on 30 east for about 30 miles and the Host is on your right side.

From Washington DC: Take 295 North to I-95 North to 695 West to I-83 North to York. At York take Rte. 30 East and follow this for about 30 miles. Hotel is on your right.

From New York: Take NJ Turnpike South to PA Turnpike (I-276_ to I-76 West to Exit 21 (Route 222). Take 222 South to Rte. 30 East. The Hotel will be approximately 7 miles ahead on right side of Rt. 30.

From Boston, MA: Take Rte. 66 West to I-84 West to Rte. 689 South to Rte. 287. Take 287 across the Tappan Zee Bridge to Rte. 78. Follow Rte. 78 West to Rte. 222 South to Rte. 30 EAST. The Host will be approximately 5 miles down on your right.

From Wilmington, DE: Take Rte. 48 West to Rte. 41 North to Rte. 30 West. You will be on 30 West for about 10 miles. The Host will be on your left

From Dover, DE: Take Rte. 13 North to Rte. 41 North. Then Rte. 41 North to Rte. 30 West. You will be on 30 West for about 10 miles. The Host will be on your left.

Airports:

Philadelphia International Airport is ~ 72 miles & approximately 90 minutes. Take I 95 South, towards Chester PA, ~ 6 miles then take I 476 North/Blue Route, (Towards Plymouth Meeting). Take 476 ~ 15 minutes until you see Route 30, take this West towards Lancaster ~ 60 miles west. Hotel will be on your Left.

BWI International is ~ 70 miles & approximately 90 minutes. Proceed out of the Airport, ~ 2 miles get onto I 95 North (Towards Baltimore). Get immediately to the left lane & merge onto I- 695 North, Baltimore Beltway - towards Towson. (Also known as the Inner Beltway.) Stay on I- 695 for 17 miles to I - 83 North, towards York, PA. Travel on I- 83, 44 miles until you see US Route 30, take this East for 30 miles to Lancaster, the hotel is on the right.

Harrisburg PA is ~ 30 miles & approximately 45 minutes.

ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS are to be made payable to the **Potomac Afghan Hound Club**. **ALL ENTRIES ARE TO BE MAILED WITH FEES (in U.S. funds) to Nancy Leuba, 9555 Persimmon Tree Road, Potomac MD 20854.** Entries will not be accepted if received without fees and/or signature. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being placed on a **cash only** basis for future entries.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE will be required for each dog entered. This recording fee is included in the entry fee and will be paid to the American Kennel Club by the Potomac Afghan Hound Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (Ch. 11, Sec. 2).

THERE WILL BE NO JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES AT THIS SHOW.

THE SHOW SITE WILL BE OPEN FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE AT ANY TIME PRIOR TO SCHEDULED TIME OF JUDGING. DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING WILL BE EXCUSED. Puppy class entries, Bred by Exhibitor class entries, and Veterans Class entries are reminded that additional competition for Best in Puppy Classes, Best in Bred by Exhibitor Classes and Best in Veterans Classes is provided at this show.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. THEY WILL ADHERE AS CLOSELY AS POSSIBLE TO THE JUDGING SCHEDULE. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON LEASH, except when being judged, or in their crates or pens. No Exceptions.

NO GASOLINE OR DIESEL GENERATORS are permitted inside the Hotel or outside of the show ring. No Exceptions.

CASH PRIZES WILL BE PAID IN THE RING TO THE PERSON SHOWING THE DOG.

Claims for cash prize money must be made in the show ring before judging is over for the show. The Potomac Afghan Hound Club and the Show Secretary disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the show is over.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management,, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS IN MAKING OUT ENTRY FORMS and no entry will be refunded in the event of such errors, or for cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
