An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Entries Close . . . 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, August 30, 2006 at the address of the Show Secretary, after which time entries cannot be accepted, changed or canceled. Canadian exhibitors & international exhibitors must make money orders payable in U.S. Funds.

Entries will not be accepted without fees.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Field Trial. For Afghan Hounds who are AKC registered and have not had their coats shaved and meet all AKC eligibility requirements according to the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 8 and are confirmed Field Champions or Coursers of Merit. NOTE: A copy of the certificate awarding the title or a copy of the ENTIRE PAGE from either the AKC Gazette or FAN magazine publishing the title will be accepted as proof. Dogs will not be entered into this class without proof of title accompanying the entry form. *The first place Winner, if undefeated in the show, is eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition.* Judging of this class will commence immediately following Winners Dog.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class. For Stud Dogs and at least two, and a maximum of four of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get

be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. All Get must be entered in a regular class, BOB or Field Trial Dog.

Brood Bitch Class. Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

In accordance with AKC rule Ch 11, Sec 8, a neutered dog may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in a Brood Bitch class.

Brace Class. Two Afghan Hounds with at least one common owner. Both dogs must be entered in a regular class, BOB or Field Trial Class.

Note: As the judge's decision in the Brace, Stud Dog, and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Pre-Novice: Pre-Novice shall be for any dog that has not received a Third qualifying score in a Novice class prior to the closing of the trial. All exercises will be scored as in Novice class, except the dogs will perform all exercises on leash, which should be long enough to provide adequate slack. There is no off leash heeling. Pre-Novice will not count toward the Triathlon.

Graduate Novice: The Graduate Novice class is for dogs that have not been certified by a judge to have received a third qualifying score toward a CDX title prior to the closing of entries. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may handle more than one dog in this class, but each dog must have a separate handler for the Long Down exercise when judged in the same group. Dogs entered in Graduate Novice may also be entered in one of the Novice or Open classes.

Veterans: The Veterans class shall be for dogs that have an Obedience Title and are seven or more years old on the day of this Obedience Trial. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice class.

Brace: The dogs need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled in accordance with AKC rules. A separate official entry form must be completed in full for each dog entered. Exercises, performances and judging shall be as in the Novice class.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS ELIGIBILITY

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:

Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; Individually registered with The American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.

Liberty Class No Entry Fee: Just Bring your dog, and the music (on cassette or compact disc) to show off your dog and spend 2 minutes alone in the ring with your dog (young, old, in costume) doing whatever you want to do to show off your dog. This will be held on Thursday September 21, 2006.

Parade of Veterans Eligibility: Open to all dogs and bitches 7 years of age or older. These entries will not be judged in conformation competition. Each dog will be presented a Rosette with its name inscribed. A Bronze Medallion depicting the Club Emblem, suspended from a Red, White & Blue Ribbon will also be offered by the Afghan Hound Club of America, Inc. **VETERANS IN THE PARADE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE IN ANY REGULAR OR NON-REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASS AT THIS SHOW**, but may compete in obedience. The dog **MUST BE PRESENT IN THE RING** in order to receive the award. **NOTE:** Please send a maximum of one page resume of dog to Show Secretary, to be read over the Public Address System while dog is in the show ring. **PLEASE PRINT DOG'S NAME CLEARLY FOR RIBBON IMPRINT.** See page 10 for form.

Parade of Rescue Open to all Afghan Hounds who have been adopted through a rescue program or shelter. We honor those of you who have taken these beautiful Afghan Hounds into your lives. The Afghan Hound Club of America will present each **RESCUED AFGHAN HOUND IN THIS PARADE** with a rosette inscribed with the dog's name. The dog **MUST BE PRESENT IN THE RING** in order to receive the award. **NOTE:** Please send a maximum of one page resume of dog to Show Secretary, to be read over the Public Address System while dog is in the show ring. **PLEASE PRINT DOG'S NAME CLEARLY FOR RIBBON IMPRINT.** See page 10 for form.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

NOTE - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2005 AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club **TEL: (919) 816-3776**

Novice Junior Class- for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class- for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class- for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class- for boys and girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class- for boys and girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class- for boys and girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Best Junior Handler: The Junior Handler placed first in each of the regular Junior Showmanship Classes, if undefeated in any other Junior Showmanship Class at this show, shall automatically be eligible to compete for this prize. A minimum of two class winners must be present to compete for the award.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the same show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship Only

The winner of first place in each Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the corresponding Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further provided that there is one or more Junior Handler competing in that Open Class.
