JUMP HEIGHT CARD

All dogs competing in Agility must present a valid official Jump Height Card.

For dogs two years and older, Owners/Handlers must present a permanent height card at check-in or be measured prior to competing.

For dogs under two years of age, the Owner/Handler must present a temporary height card at check-in or be measured prior to competing.

Dogs that do not have a Jump Height Card, will be measured by a Judge of record for that trial and will only be effective for that set of trials, excluding the dogs jumping in the 24-inch height division.

Misrepresentation of a dog, including altering information on a Jump Height Card, is grounds for misconduct. Exhibitors should carry the original valid official Jump Height Card at each trial to present upon request.

In accordance with Chapter 2, Section 3 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, dogs wicketed by the judge of record may not be moved down in jump height.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility.

MOVEUPS

E-MAILED or FAXED MOVEUPS: When e-mailing a moveup to us please just give the following information. TRIAL NAME & Date, Owner Name, Dog Call Name, AKC#, Breed, Move up for what days (Saturday, Sunday, etc.), Moving from, Moving to (PLEASE include STD or JWW). Move-ups are due by 6:00PM (Eastern) on Monday, September 11, 2006.

MOVEUP DEADLINES: Dogs can be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00PM (Eastern) on Monday, September 11, 2006.

NOVICE MOVEUPS: Dogs having attained their first AKC Agility Title (Std **OR** JWW) must be moved to the Novice B Class (Std **and** JWW) for all trials that have not reached the closing date. Once a trial closing date has past, a dog cannot be moved from Novice A to Novice B. If the trial has already reached the closing date on the day the dog obtained its title, the dog shall remain in the class in which it was originally entered. The dog can also be moved up a level (Novice to Open) at the request of the owner subject to the normal move-up criteria.

****TRIAL REGULATIONS NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS ****

THE TRIAL will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be fifteen months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration or ILP registration. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on show grounds.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to Judging, if a copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring before their class begins.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

EQUIPMENT

The equipment for this event is being provided by M.A.D. If you are interested in a specific item, it is requested that you reserve it ahead of time.

REFUNDS: There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date.

Refunds after closing date for bitches in season only. A \$5.00 processing fee for **ANY** refunds. **ALL REFUNDS MUST INCLUDE OWNER'S NAME AND MAILING ADDRESS WITH REQUEST.**

BITCHES IN SEASON are not eligible to participate. Entry fees will be refunded subject to a \$5.00 processing fee.

Written verification from a veterinarian is required. **Notification for refund of bitches in season must be made no later than 48 hrs after end of the trial. A Veterinarian's note AND Trial Confirmation for dog must accompany any such refund request.**

ROUTES TO SHOW SITE

From Baltimore: Take I-83 North to Rt. 30 East. Stay on 30 east for about 30 miles and the Host is on your right side.

From Washington DC: Take 295 North to I-95 North to 695 West to I-83 North to York. At York take Rte. 30 East and follow this for about 30 miles. Hotel is on your right.

From New York: Take NJ Turnpike South to PA Turnpike (I-276 to I-76 West to Exit 21 (Route 222). Take 222 South to Rte. 30 East. The Hotel will be approximately 7 miles ahead on right side of Rt. 30.

From Boston, MA: Take Rte. 66 West to I-84 West to Rte. 689 South to Rte. 287. Take 287 across the Tappan Zee Bridge to Rte. 78. Follow Rte. 78 West to Rte. 222 South to Rte. 30 EAST. The Host will be approximately 5 miles down on your right.

From Wilmington, DE: Take Rte. 48 West to Rte. 41 North to Rte. 30 West. You will be on 30 West for about 10 miles. The Host will be on your left

From Dover, DE: Take Rte. 13 North to Rte. 41 North. Then Rte. 41 North to Rte. 30 West. You will be on 30 West for about 10 miles. The Host will be on your left.

AIRPORTS

Philadelphia International Airport is ~ 72 miles & approximately 90 minutes. Take I-95 South, towards Chester PA, ~ 6 miles then take I 476 North/Blue Route, (Towards Plymouth Meeting). Take 476 ~ 15 minutes until you see Route 30, take this West towards Lancaster ~ 60 miles west. Hotel will be on your Left.

BWI International is ~ 70 miles & approximately 90 minutes. Proceed out of the Airport, ~ 2 miles get onto I-95 North (Towards Baltimore). Get immediately to the left lane & merge onto I- 695 North, Baltimore Beltway - towards Towson. (Also known as the Inner Beltway.) Stay on I- 695 for 17 miles to I- 83 North, towards York, PA. Travel on I- 83, 44 miles until you see US Route 30, take this East for 30 miles to Lancaster, the hotel is on the right.

Harrisburg PA is ~ 30 miles & approximately 45 minutes.
