### DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all Afghan Hounds over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained an **AKC** ILP number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. All other Breeds are not eligible to enter.

### CLASSES AND DIVISIONS

Novice, Open and Excellent Standard Regular and Preferred Classes will be offered. The Novice and Excellent classes will be divided into Division A & Division B as further described in Chapter 2, Section 1 of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Novice Standard Agility class and the Novice JWW Classes are divided into Divisions A & B, Division A is for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility title.

Novice, Open & Excellent JWW Regular and Preferred Classes will be offered. The Novice & Excellent Classes will be divided into Division A & Division B as further described in Ch 5, Sec 2 of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no crossover between them allowed at the same set of trials. **FOR MORE INFORMATION ABOUT CLASSES, RULES, ETC. ### HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure any dog entered in the trials. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard and the jumpers with weaves classes. Dogs may only be entered in one jump height division per day for all classes. In the Standard and Jumpers with Weaves Classes, dogs may jump at a higher height division; however, this is not allowed in the Preferred Classes.

### JUMP HEIGHT CARD

All dogs competing in Agility must present a valid official Jump Height Card.

For dogs two years and older, Owners/Handlers must present a permanent height card at check-in or be measured prior to competing.

For dogs under two years of age, the Owner/Handler must present a temporary height card at check-in or be measured prior to competing.

Dogs that do not have a Jump Height Card, will be measured by a Judge of record for that trial and will only be effective for that set of trials, excluding the dogs jumping in the 24-inch height division.

Misrepresentation of a dog, including altering information on a Jump Height Card, is grounds for misconduct. Exhibitors should carry the original valid official Jump Height Card at each trial to present upon request.

In accordance with Chapter 2, Section 3 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, dogs wicketed by the judge of record may not be moved *down* in jump height.

### \*\*TRIAL REGULATIONS NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS\*\*

**THE TRIAL** will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check. **TELEPHONE AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES** cannot be accepted.

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

**Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope.** Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

**ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES** will be made as soon as trial closes or limits are reached. Acknowledgment of entries will include confirmation notices.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the match, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS**-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

## CONSULT CONFIRMATION FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

**JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**TRIAL COMMITTEE** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

**DOGS PARTICIPATING** must be fifteen months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club or have an AKC Limited Registration or ILP registration. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on show grounds.

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to Judging, if a copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring before their class begins.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**MOVEUP DEADLINES:** Dogs can be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary not later than 6:00PM (Eastern) on Monday, September 11, 2006.

**NOVICE MOVEUPS:** Dogs having attained their first AKC Agility Title (Std **OR** JWW) must be moved to the Novice B Class (Std **and** JWW) for all trials that have not reached the closing date. Once a trial closing date has past, a dog cannot be moved from Novice A to Novice B. If the trial has already reached the closing date on the day the dog obtained its title, the dog shall remain in the class in which it was originally entered. The dog can also be moved up a level (Novice to Open) at the request of the owner subject to the normal move-up criteria.

## ROUTES TO SHOW SITE

**From Baltimore:** Take I-83 North to Rt. 30 East. Stay on 30 east for about 30 miles and the Host is on your right side.

**From Washington DC:** Take 295 North to I-95 North to 695 West to I-83 North to York. At York take Rte. 30 East and follow this for about 30 miles. Hotel is on your right.

**From New York:** Take NJ Turnpike South to PA Turnpike (I-276 to I-76 West to Exit 21 (Route 222). Take 222 South to Rte. 30 East. The Hotel will be approximately 7 miles ahead on right side of Rt. 30.

**From Boston, MA:** Take Rte. 66 West to I-84 West to Rte. 689 South to Rte. 287. Take 287 across the Tappan Zee Bridge to Rte. 78. Follow Rte. 78 West to Rte. 222 South to Rte. 30 EAST. The Host will be approximately 5 miles down on your right.
