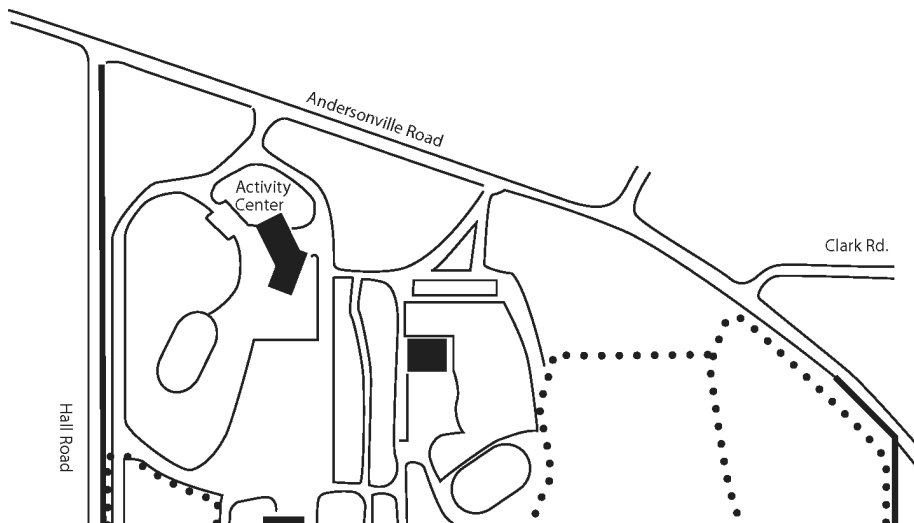

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW

Show Site is South of Flint or East of Clarkson, MI

Coming from I-75 Exit 93 (Dixie Hwy Waterford): Go one mile South to White Lake Road and turn right. Go to Andersonville Rd and turn right. Show Site is 5 miles on left hand side.

Coming from US 23 Exit at M-59: East to Ormond Rd., (divided highway, you will have to turn left then turn right (North) onto Ormond.). Follow Ormond Rd. 3.5 miles to dead end at the White Lake Rd. Jog right and then left back onto Ormond Rd. Continue on Ormond Rd. for 4 miles until it dead ends at Davisburg Rd. Turn right onto Davisburg Rd. Turn right onto Andersonville Rd., and go 1 mile to showsite OR once on Davisburg Rd., follow large brown wooden park signs to 4H Fair Oakland County Springfield Oaks Recreation.

IMPORTANT - TRANSFERS of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch 11, Sec 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

Move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations Chapter 1 Section 16.

Trophies, certificates, ribbons and prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog who shall be considered the owner or agent. All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging and the Show Secretary advised at once of any discrepancy.

The ESSCM has been assured there is adequate electrical power for all exhibitors.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building. Generators can be used outside for grooming. The ESSCM will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog on the show grounds, whether as a result of an accident or any other cause. It is clearly understood that every dog entered in the show is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children the day of the show.
