ROUTES TO THE SHOW

Parking for the show is in the outer parking lot near the golf range.

FROM THE NORTH, EAST OR WEST: Find your best route to Rt. 22. Take the Rt. 191 exit. At the end of the ramp, turn right onto Rt. 191 north. One tenth of a mile from the exit ramp, turn RIGHT onto Brodhead Road (before the Brodhead Road stoplight). Follow Brodhead until you come to a stop sign, turn right onto Hecktown Road. Proceed past the Hecktown Road Entrance to the campus and turn left onto Green Pond Road at the stop light. The Green Pond Road Entrance to the campus will be on your right.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take Rt 78 to Rt 33 north. Go to the second exit, William Penn Highway, and turn left. Pass Farmersville Elementary School on the left, the Municipal Building on the right. Take the first right after the Municipal Building onto Oakland Rd. Stay on Oakland Rd until you see the entrance to NCC on your right.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The show site will be available to exhibitors after 5PM Friday October 6. The show will be open from 8:00am to 7:00pm. Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. Dogs must be removed at the conclusion of all judging.

IMPORTANT - TRANSFERS of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch. 11, Section 6, AKC Rules) MUST be made to the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

Obedience Move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations Chapter 1 Section 16.

The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the ring side when its breed is to be judged.

Dogs may arrive anytime before judging begins.

Judging Will Begin Promptly As Scheduled. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

No Gasoline or Diesel Generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

Bitch In Season in Obedience Competition Only, a refund of all but \$3.00 of the entry fee for the Obedience Class(es) will be returned upon sending a veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary postmarked before the opening day of the show; or given to the Show Secretary before the start of the show.

No dogs will be allowed on the show grounds except those entered in the show.

Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.

Park at your own risk. In the event of inclement weather the grounds may become soft and vehicles can get stuck. Towing will be at the expense of the vehicles owner.
