Veteran Classes. Classes for dogs & bitches 7 years & under 9 years, 9 years & under 11 years, and 11 years & over. Sexes divided.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Parade of Titleholders. Non-competitive. All Bernese Mountain Dogs that are AKC Titleholders of Record or have BMDC Draft Titles are eligible to enter the Parade. Entry fee for the Parade is \$8. Entry form must state "Titleholders Parade" and dogs do not have to be entered in another class. Each dog will receive a Rosette with the dog's name imprinted on it.

Non Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Stud Dog Class. For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog

need not necessarily be owner of Get. Award will be based on the merits of the get.

Brood Bitch Class. Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class. Each Brace shall be composed of two Bernese Mountain Dogs with identical ownership. Dogs competing in Brace Class must be entered in one a Regular Class. The additional entry fee of \$15 per dog shall be charged for this class. A separate form must be completed for each dog in Brace and mailed together with the entry fee as a unit.

In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 8 - a castrated male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class & a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

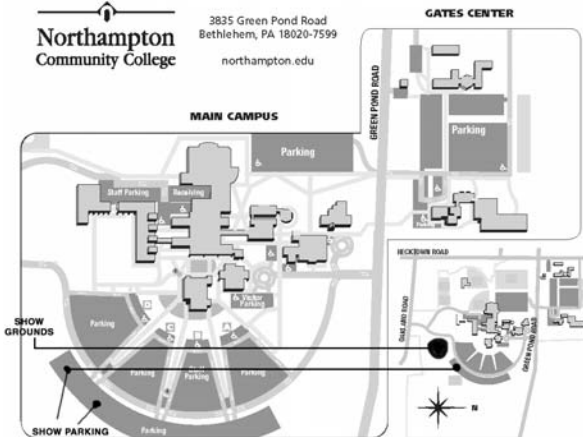

An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms & Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission & identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Postdated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
