Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.
At the discretion of the judge, a ramp may be used.
Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.
Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
Prizes: Trophies, rosettes and prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog who shall be considered the owner or agent. All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging and the Show Superintendent advised of any discrepancy. SPECIAL NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Care for the show site is of utmost importance to BCA. Whenever it shall be determined that misuse of a hotel room or show site is occurring, the Bench Show committee shall convene for the express purpose of an on-site inspection of the area in question. Should it be determined, by a hearing, that destruction and/or misuse of the property is, in fact, occurring, the following steps shall be taken to correct the matter:

- A. Monetary restitution shall immediately be made to the said hotel by the violator(s).
- B. The person, or persons, found in violation of the hotel and AKC/BCA rules shall be asked to leave the premises immediately; and
- C. If suspended from all AKC privileges, the offender's name shall be published in the AKC Gazette and the BULLDOGGER as having been found guilty in violation of the said AKC/BCA rules.
