**Veteran Class.** Classes for Dogs and Bitches 7 years & older. Undefeated dogs and bitches that have competed at this show in the Veteran Classes shall compete for Best of Breed. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes at independent specialty shows.

### BEST OF BREED

#### Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

**Stud Dog Class.** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Award will be based on the merits of two of the get. Get must be individually entered in one of the breed classes in this show for which it is eligible.

**Brood Bitch Class.** Same as Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

**Open Junior** - for boys/girls 9-12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Intermediate** - for boys/girls 12-15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Senior** - for boys/girls 15-18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places with competition present in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

**Be Sure All Information** for Junior classes is entered on the front & back of the entry form.

**ENTRY FEES:** \$25.00 for the first entry of each dog (including \$0.50 AKC recording fee & \$1.50 Event Service Fee, or \$3.00 if for Rally), except Puppy (6-9 & 9-12) and Bred By Exhibitor which are \$20.00, and each additional entry of the same dog is \$20.00. All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**Telegraph, telephone, unsigned entries** cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms & photocopies of entry forms without Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are **not acceptable**.

**Entries received without fees will not be accepted.**

**Acknowledgment of entries** will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission & identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Superintendent.

**No entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**Postdated Checks** and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on CASH ONLY basis.
