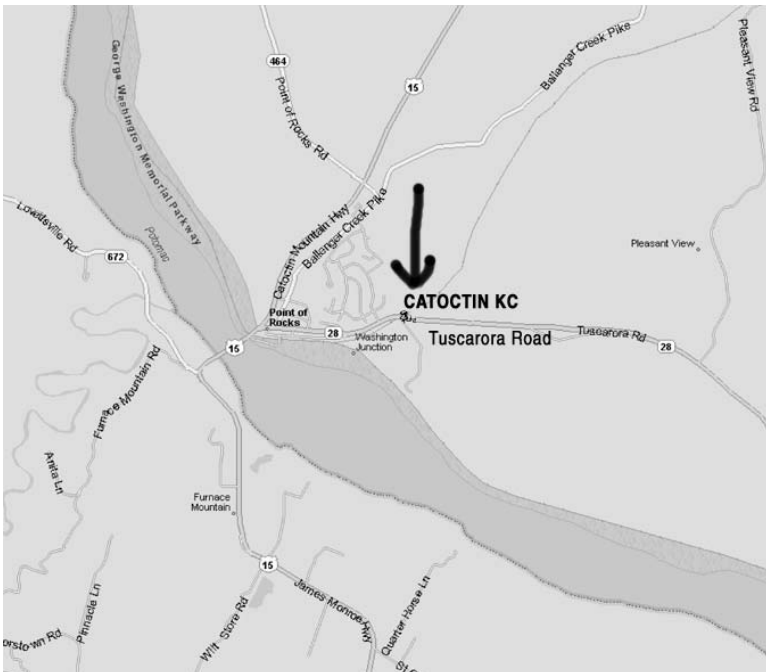
**From the South:** The ‘country route’, a bit curvy and hilly in parts. I-270 to Urbana (exit 26). West on Route 80 to Route 85 (approx. 5 miles). Left onto Route 85, follow 85 South to Route 28 (approx. 5 miles). Right on Route 28 to Rock Hall Rd. in Point of Rocks (approx. 4 miles). Rock Hall Rd. intersects with Route 28 just prior to the railroad crossing. Left onto Rock Hall Rd. and left into the parking area.

### **OR if you prefer highway driving,**

continue North on I-270 to I-70 West toward Hagerstown. Upon entering I-70 immediately move to the right and take exit 52 to US 340W/US 15 South toward Charlestown/Leesburg. Bear off on US 15 South toward Leesburg and follow directions below (From the North and East).

**From the North and East:** I-70 to US 340W/US 15 South. Follow US 15 South toward Leesburg. At the flashing light just prior to the Potomac River Bridge in Point of Rocks, turn left onto Route 28. Turn right on Rock Hall Rd. just after crossing the railroad tracks, and left into the parking area.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries** Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms & Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

**Entries received without fees will not be accepted.**

**Acknowledgment of entries** will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission & identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Superintendent.

**Dogs may arrive** at any time prior to judging. **Dogs not required** for further judging will be excused.

**No entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**Postdated Checks** and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on CASH ONLY basis.

**No Refund** for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

**Errors** on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
