From the South: New Jersey Turnpike to I-287, North to US 22, West to US 202 South. US 202 South to Milltown Rd. to show grounds.

From New Hope-Lambertville-Philadelphia Area: US 202 North to Milltown Rd., Left on Milltown Rd. to show grounds.

From Easton-Phillipsburg Area I-78 East to US 22 East (Annandale), US 22 East to US 202 South, US 202 South to Milltown Rd. to show grounds.

From Trenton Area US 206 North to US 202 (Somerville Circle), US 202 South to Milltown Rd. Right on Milltown Rd. to show grounds.

From Connecticut-New York Area I-287 South (Exit 17) to US 202 South, US 202 South to Milltown Rd. Right on Milltown Rd. to show grounds.

From South Jersey Area Garden State Parkway North to I-287, North to US 22, West to US 202 South. US 202 South to Milltown Rd. Right on Milltown Rd. to show grounds.

No dogs will be allowed on the show grounds except those entered in the show.
