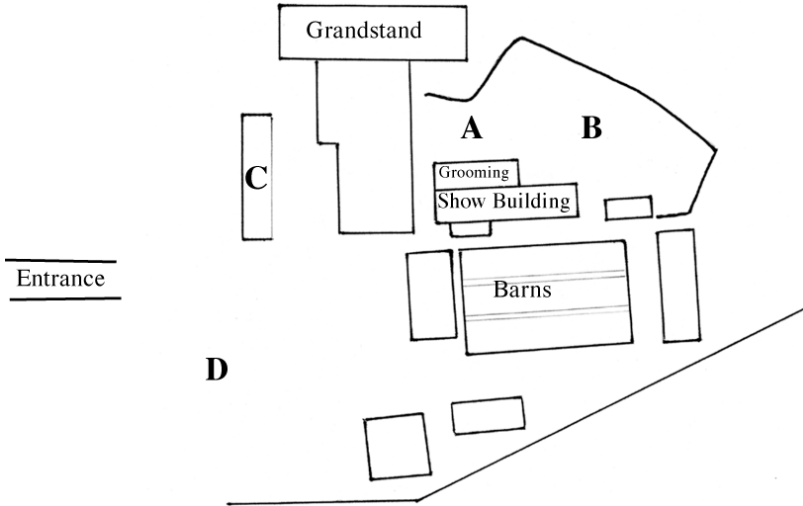

No ex-pens or baby strollers will be allowed in the buildings.

Cars blocking exits or no parking areas will be towed/ticketed by local police, or fairground security.

Dog's left in cars or crates will be removed if the animal appears to be in distress! **WAIVER OF RIGHTS:**

All persons attending these dog shows hereby waive any claim for damages against the Tri-Star Kennel Club of Williamson County Tennessee or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

No gasoline or gas generators will be allowed within 100 feet of the Show Buildings, or other buildings on the fairgrounds.

Parents bringing children – be responsible – keep an eye on your children.

Please pick up after your dogs and yourself so we can continue to use the facility.

An admittance fee will be charged to anyone attending the dog show, so please bring your show ID supplied by the superintendent to avoid having to pay. Also, have your hand stamped before leaving the building.

HOTELS AND MOTELS

Dogs must be crated while in the hotel rooms.

Do not let your dogs destroy or foul the rooms.

All camping & RV parking will be allowed in designated areas only as per fairgrounds guidelines. All visitors must follow the directions of the Tri-Star Kennel Club Committee members who will direct you to the correct parking area. All parking regulations will be strictly enforced. Violators will be asked to move or their vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

The Fairgrounds have dumpsites in the lower camping areas for motor homes that park in the dry camping area. No open dumping. There are also restrooms in this area as well. All exhibitors parking or camping in the reserved area, as well as any other area on the property are required to clean up after yourself, and after your dogs.

The Club, its Members, Directors, Officers, Agents, Superintendent, State of Tennessee, or their employees, will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, injury and/or death of dogs entered in these events, whether said disappearance, loss, theft, injury and/or death is or are caused by the negligence or carelessness of the Kennel Club, its Members, Directors, Officers, Agents, Superintendent and/or State of Tennessee, or its employees or by negligence of any person or by any other cause.

ENTRY FEES (each show): First entry of each dog in each show is \$24, except for Puppy Classes (6-9 or 9-12 months) which are \$16 (Includes \$0.50 cents AKC Recording Fee & \$1.50 AKC Event Service Fee). Each additional entry of the same dog in the same show is \$24, except for Junior Showmanship which is Free as an additional entry.

An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2).

All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. *(In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)*
