**Veteran Classes.** Classes for dogs & bitches 8 years & under 10, and 10 years & over. Sexes divided.

**Hunting Retriever Classes.** Classes for dogs & bitches that have earned an AKC Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter or Master Hunter title. Sexes divided.

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

**Awards Of Merit.** The Judge may select up to 10% of the superior quality specimens in addition to the Best of Breed and BOS to BOB from the intersex competition.

**Non Regular Classes**

**Involving Multiple Dog Entries**

**Stud Dog Class.** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular Classes, or if a Champion of Record, for Best of Breed (Variety) Competition or may be entered for Stud Dog Class Competition Only at the regular entry fee. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires only one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed.

**Brood Bitch Class.** Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Brace Class.** Each Brace shall be composed of two Golden Retrievers with at least one common owner. All braces must be entered in the Brace Class and shown in the ring at the same time. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered "Brace Class Only", and pay a separate Regular Class fee for each dog which is not otherwise entered.

In accordance with Ch 11, Sec 8 - a castrated male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class & a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

**OBEEDIENCE TRIAL CLASS**

**Graduate Novice** - The Graduate Novice Class shall be for CD dogs that have not received a third qualifying score towards a CDX prior to close of entries.

**Veterans Obedience** - The Veterans Class is for dogs that have an Obedience title and are seven (7) years or older on the date of the trial. Dogs entered may **not** be entered in another obedience class.

**Brace Obedience** - The Brace Class shall be for two Golden Retrievers capable of performing the NOVICE exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog comprising the brace with one entry fee. Indicate this class as Brace Obedience.

**Move-ups** will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations Chapter 1 Section 16.

The show will be open from 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day. Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging.

Closing Date: 12 Noon (Eastern), Wednesday, January 24, 2007, at Superintendent's office, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11 Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. Mail All Entries With Fees to Bob Peters Dog Shows, Superintendent, P.O. Box 579, Wake Forest, NC 27588-0579. Checks payable to Bob Peters Dog Shows.

Entry fees for each show: \$25 for the first entry of each dog in each show (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee & Event Service Fee of \$1.50) and each additional entry of the same dog in the same show is \$18. Junior Showmanship Competition is \$15. Sweepstakes is \$12 and must be entered in a regular class. Veteran Sweepstakes is \$12.

If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2).

An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

Make All Checks and Money Orders payable to Bob Peters Dog Shows, LTD., CANADIAN exhibitors must make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms & Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission & identification before the dog will be received. Should such acknowledgment not be received by exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Superintendent.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Postdated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Gasoline or Diesel Generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

No dogs will be allowed on the show grounds except those entered in the show. dogs may arrive at any time prior to judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.

All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against Long Island Golden Retriever Club, Inc. or its members, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
