**IMPORTANT - TRANSFERS** of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition (Ch. 11, Sec 6, AKC Rules) **MUST** be made to the Show Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

**Move-ups** will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations Ch 1 Sec 16.

The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the ring side when its breed is to be judged.

The YGRC has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

The show will be open from 7 am to 8 pm. Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging, and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of Riots, Civil Disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**The Yankee Golden Retriever Club**, Crackerbarrel Fairgrounds, Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

**No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

**Errors** on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**No Gasoline or Diesel Generators** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

**Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.**

**Please note the following policy in regard to dogs in guestrooms**

## ROUTE TO THE SHOW

**From I-95:** Take Exit 7- Rte 140 towards Foxboro. Follow for 3-4 miles to Rte 1A. Turn right onto Rte 1A. Follow for approximately 1 mile to the flashing light (North Street on the Left, Winter Street on the Right). Turn Left onto North Street. Take the first Left onto Emerald Street. Entrance to site is approximately 1/4 mile on the Right.

**From I-495:** Take Exit 15- Rte 1A North towards Wrentham. After crossing Rte 140 follow approximately 1 mile to flashing light (North Street on the Left and Winter Street on the Right) Turn Left onto North Street. Take the first Left onto Emerald Street. Entrance to site is approximately 1/4 mile on the Right.
