AKC Hunting Retriever Classes. For dogs or bitches who have earned an AKC Hunting Retriever Title. Sexes Divided.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

**Non Regular Classes
Involving Multiple Dog Entries**

Stud Dog Class. For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of Get. Award will be based on the merits of the get. If the get are not entered in one of the other classes in this show for which it is eligible the regular entry fee must be paid. A single entry fee of \$25 will be charged for this class unless the Get are not entered in any regular or non-regular class in which case it shall be entered for Stud Dog Class only and the regular fee shall be paid.

Brood Bitch Class. Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class. Each Brace shall be composed of two Golden Retrievers with at least one common owner All braces must be entered in the Brace Class and shown in the ring at the same time. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered

“Brace Class Only”, and pay a separate Regular Class fee for each dog which is not otherwise entered.

In accordance with Chapter 11, Section 9 - a castrated male may be entered in the Stud Dog Class & a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As a judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASS

Move-ups will be permitted in accordance with Obedience Regulations Ch 1 Sec 16.

Pre-Novice. Exercises in this class are the same as in Novice except are performed on a leash.

Graduate Novice. Dog must not have been awarded their 3rd CDX Leg. Do not need to have a CD to compete. May enter Novice or Open classes at the same trial.

Veterans Obedience. The Veterans Class is for dogs that have an Obedience title and are seven (7) years or older on the date of the trial.

Brace Obedience. The Brace Class shall be for Braces of dogs of the same breed that are eligible under these regulations and capable of performing the NOVICE exercises. The dogs need not be owned by the same person, but must be handled by one handler. Dogs may be shown unattached or coupled, the coupling device to be not less than six inches overall length; whichever method is used must be used continued throughout all exercises.

Team. This Class is for teams of any four dogs that are eligible under AKC Regulations. Five may be entered, one to be an alternate for which no entry fee will be required. The same four dogs will perform all exercises. Dogs comprising an obedience team do not need to have the same owner. Show “Team Obed” on each dog's entry form. Dogs entered in “Team only” need to have a complete entry form submitted. Fee is \$25.00 for unit, **send one check for the unit (do not divide up the entry fee among the dogs in the team). Please send with your entry a sheet listing all team members.**

Handler's Choice Versatility This class is for dogs capable of performing the Utility exercises. Dogs in this class may be entered in another class or classes. Six exercises will be performed. The handler selects two each from the Novice, Open and Utility classes. There will be no group exercises.

Parade of Champions and Titleholders

This non-competitive event will be held during the lunch break for any dog holding an AKC and/or GRCA title. For each entry indicate “Parade” in the space provided for Additional Classes. Fee is \$15.00. A commemorative rosette bearing the dog's name will be presented for each dog entered. Along with the entry a brief description of fifty (50) words or less, should be sent. Please include the dogs name and titles, call name, owners name and a summary of the dogs achievements.

RALLY TRIAL CLASSES

Entry fees for Rally: \$25

The Rally Novice A Class. Dogs competing in this class may not have won an AKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner's household or immediate family. The handler may not have previously handled any dog that has earned an AKC Rally title or any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility title. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After a dog earns the Rally Novice (RN) title, it may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

The Rally Novice B Class. Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Novice A and Rally Novice B at any one trial.

The Rally Advanced A Class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) title or any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner's household or immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After a dog earns the Rally Advanced (RA) title, it may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

The Rally Advanced B Class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

The Rally Excellent A Class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any AKC Novice, Open, or Utility title. A handler must own the dog entered or be a member of the owner's household or immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. After earning the Rally Excellent (RE) title, a dog may continue to compete in this class for 60 days. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

The Rally Excellent B Class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (RE) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

Veteran Sweepstakes Eligibility: Any purebred Golden Retriever, eight years of age and older. Entrants must be entered in another class at this show.
